## Students get inside look at community band

The Palmyra-Eagle Community Band, with financial help from the Palmyra Kiwanis Club, presented a series of "School Day Band Concerts" to local elementary schools in Jefferson and Waukesha counties.

On May 14, 24 musicians, under the direction of Guest Director Ken Olson of Eagle, along with five high school band students, held a concert for approximately 74 first and second grade students. Their teachers Lisa Martin, Debra Lawler, Polly Mueller, Jan Schmidt and student teacher Rita VanDyke also enjoyed the concert held in the Palmyra Elementary School gym.

Prior to the concert, the music director gave a short introduction and welcome to the students followed by a brief explanation about how some of the band instruments work together to create music.

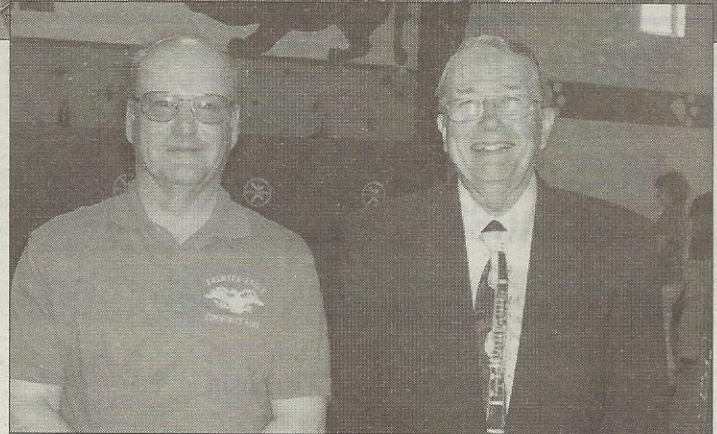
The band played six pieces: The Swing March, The Teddy Bear's Picnic, The Mickey Mouse March, The Lion Sleeps Tonight, On Wisconsin and the snappy Thunderer March. Between each song a different set



of instruments were demonstrated to show the kind of sound it made alone and a description of the instrument itself.

Near the end of the concert Olson talked to the students about careers, explaining that each member of the band also had a career outside of the band. Students were told that they could also pursue their career dreams and still have time and energy to play music, just as the members of the Palmyra-Eagle Band do on a weekly basis.

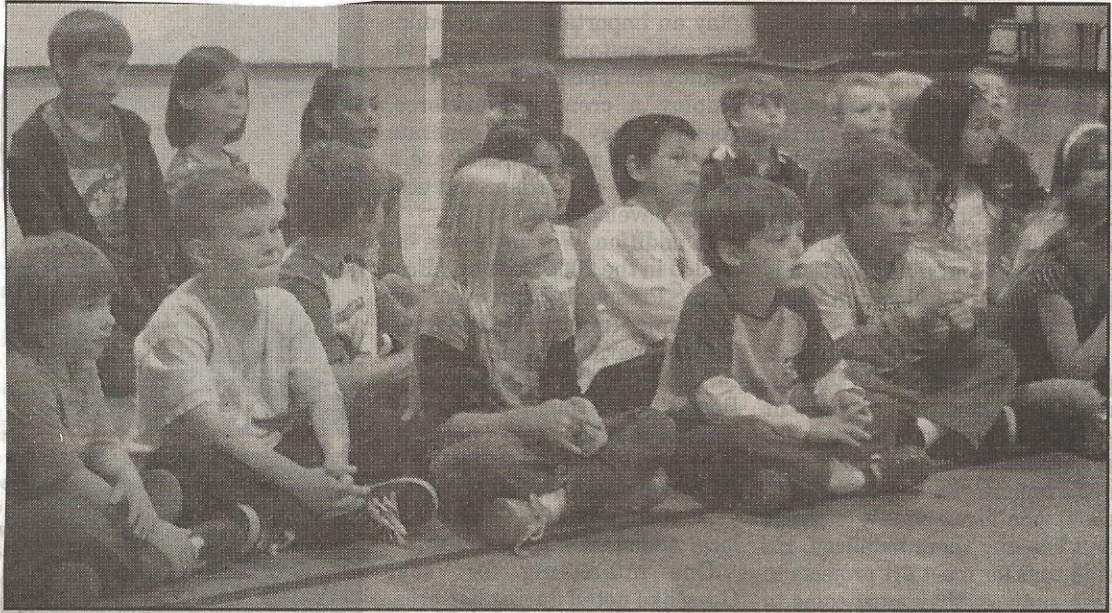
During the final song students were allowed to walk among the band members with their teachers to experience first hand what it was like to play in the band.



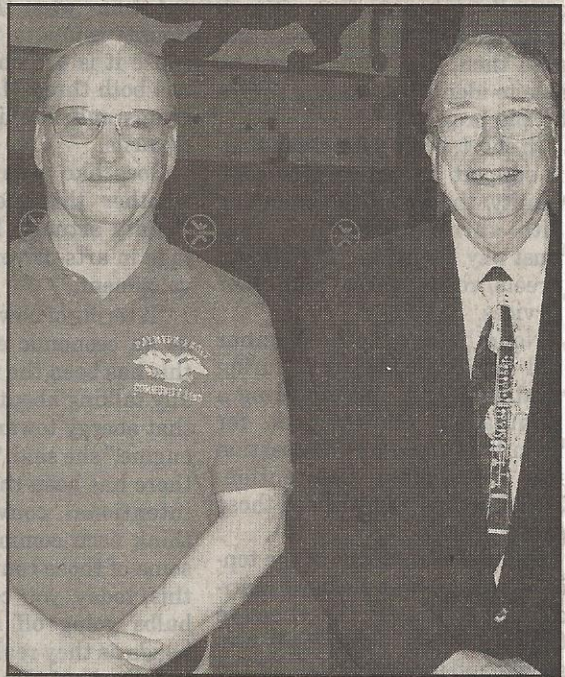

The Journal Sentinel reported this week that almost 50 large trees had fallen and damaged headstones at the cemetery. Though many volunteers had offered help, caretaker Peter Jones said the large trees required more than chainsaws. The cemetery, he said, does not have the staffing or the funds to deal with the damage itself. 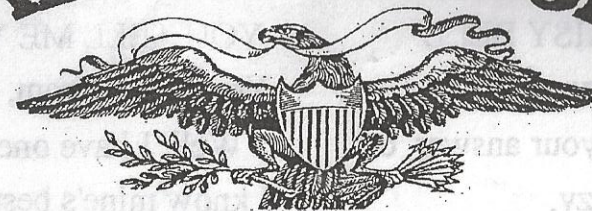

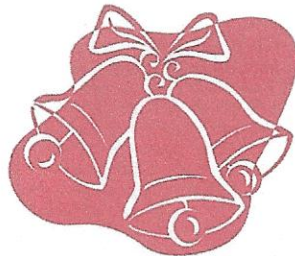
